Report from the Treasurer for March 2025.

Introduction

As the Treasurer of Grey Power, New Zealand, I am pleased to present the financial report for March 2025. This report, a testament to our commitment to financial transparency, it will cover our financial activities and status over the past month, highlighting key points of interest and areas that require attention.

Income

- Capitation Fees: The total income from Capitation Fees for this month was \$37695.63, including new
 memberships and renewals; this is down on last year but not a worry at this stage. Many associations
 have not yet paid into the Federation this year.
- Interest income at \$3039.59 within budget. But will decrease later in the year because of the lowering of interest rates.
- Newsletters Subscriptions were \$4584.90
- Other Income: Our financial versatility is evident in the additional income from diverse sources such as merchandise sales, events, and others, totalling \$489.37.
- We have also received. \$5 5576.576.52 in AGM registrations.

Expenditure

- Operational Costs: Our monthly operational costs amounted to \$28408.29, including office supplies, utilities, staff salaries, Advocacy, and Officer expenses, etc.
- We exceeded budget. In several areas last month. The main ones were. Board travel and accommodation: This was paid in advance, so it'll even be out. Our President has had a hectic month; therefore, her expenditure has been high.

Net Financial Position

At the end of [Month], our net financial position is \$841029.93. This figure represents our total income minus our total expenditures.
